Official TOEFL test scores (min. 550 for ITP paper-based, test 550 for paper-based test, 79 for
nternet-based test,and 213 for computer-based test), or IELTS test score (min. 6.5, academic
Format)

Note: TOEFL test score of 500 for ITP paper-based test, 500 for paper-based test, 173 for computer-based test, 61 for internet-based test, IELTS test score of 5.0, or equivalence can be submitted under the condition to take and pass at least two English classes required at the School of Language and Communication, NIDA, and to submit the minimum TOEFL of 530 (paper-based), 193 (computer-based), 69 (Internet-based), or IELTS score of at least 5.5 before graduation.
