A copy of official transcript(s) of all universities or colleges attended. Additionally, academic and/or professional prowess.

Official TOEFL test scores (min. 550 for NIDA ITP paper-based, test 550 for paper-based test, 79 for internet-based test, and 213 for computer-based test), or IELTS test score (min. 6.5, academic format)

Note: TOEFL test score o f 500 for NIDA ITP paper-based test, 500 for paper-based test, 173 for computer-based test, 61 for internet-based test, IELTS test score of 5.0, or equivalence can be submitted under the condition to take and pass at least two English classes required at the School of Language and Communication, NIDA, and to submit the minimum TOEFL of 530 (paper-based), 193 (computer-based), 69 (Internet-based), or IELTS score of at least 5.5 before graduation.

Three (3) letter of reference Form B, available for download at <u>https://hrd.nida.ac.th/hrd-phd/apply.php?htmlpage=10</u> from academic advisors, or profession supervisor who could justify applicant's academic performance and/or professional work.

A 3–5-page statement of purpose (written in English) described career goals and professional accomplishment objectives including research interests and program goals using 12 points. non-condensed font (e.g., Times New Roman) and 2.5 cm. margin
